- 2. A HOMEOWNER INFORMED THE BOARD IN WRITING THAT THE OIL RIG BETWEEN WHISPERING OAKS AND BRIARCREST HAS JUNK, BRUSH AND WEEDS THAT NEED TO BE CLEANED UP. CHRIS HENNING ASKED THE LETTER BE FORWARED TO HIM SO HE CAN NOTIFY THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.
- 3. ANOTHER HOMEOWNER NOTED THAT SOME PROPERTIES APPEAR TO BE ABANDONED AND HAVE NOT BEEN MAINTAINED. PLEASE CONTACT THE BOARD WITH SPECIFIC INFORMATION.
